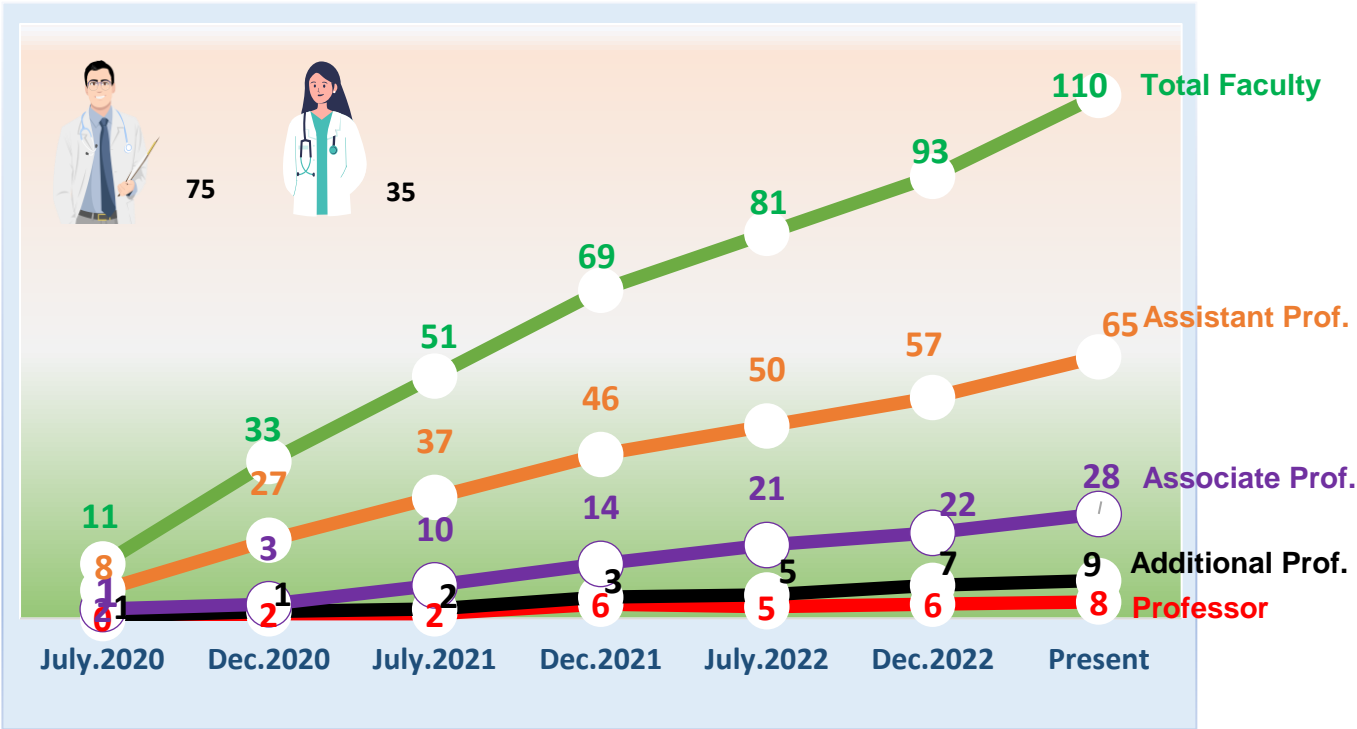
Association of tobacco control with tobacco prevalence in India

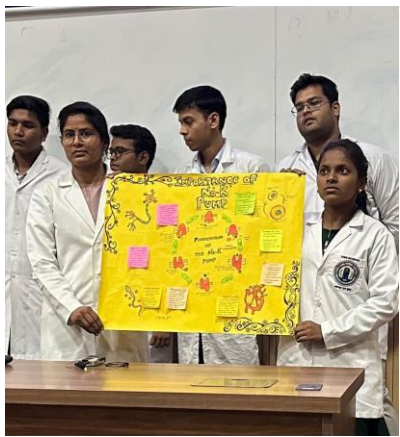


Inauguration USG services (13th May 2023)
