# Academic Endeavours



**First Endoscopic Cadaveric Workshop:** The Departments of ENT and Anatomy, AIIMS Deoghar, organized the first Basic Endoscopic Sinus Surgery Cadaveric Workshop with 10 dissectors and 15 observers. Expert demonstrations by Prof. Rakesh Kumar (AIIMS Delhi) and Prof. Rakesh Kumar Singh (IGIMS Patna), along with lectures from Anatomy, Radiodiagnosis, and Anaesthesia, enriched the two-day event. This milestone workshop significantly advanced surgical training and skill development at AIIMS Deoghar.

## 1st Cadaveric Workshop on Total Knee Replacement

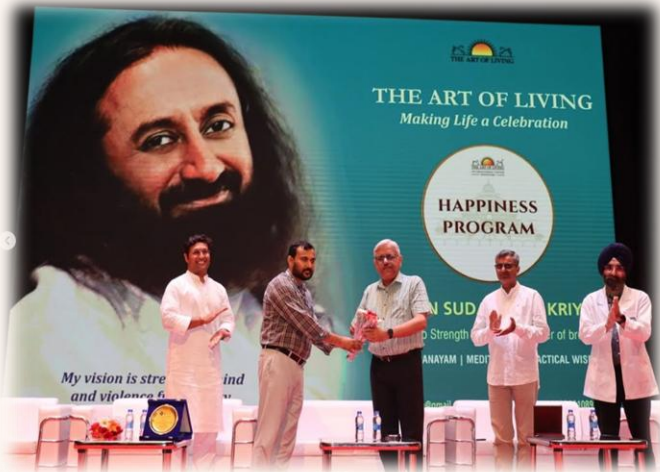
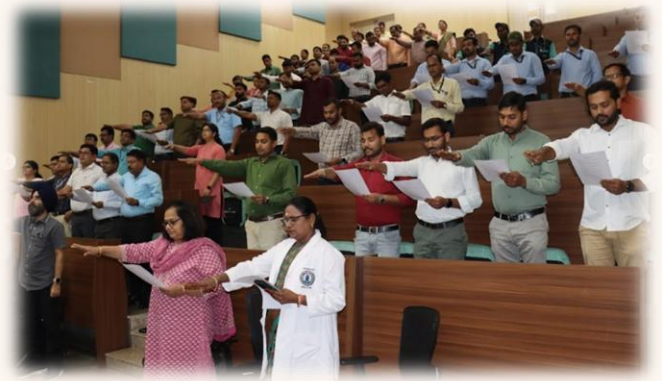
