#### **Message from Executive Director Desk**



#### हिन्दी पखवाडा २०२१ (१०-०९-२०२१)

#### World Patient Safety Day (17.09.2021)

World Patient Safety Day- Established by world health assembly, First celebrated on 17th Sept'2019. As per data, 810 women died every day in 2017 from preventable causes related to pregnancy and childbirth, 94% of all maternal deaths occur in low and lower middle-income countries. WHO decided to keep theme for World Patient safety Day 2021 as "safe maternal and newborn care" and slogan as "act now for safe and respectful childbirth". Dignitaries like Dr T S Ravikumar, Convenor IRAPS & President, AIIMS, Mangalagiri, Dr Saurabh Varshney, Executive Director, AIIMS, Deoghar, Dr Gitanjali Batmanabane, Director, AIIMS, Bhubaneswar, Dr Mukesh Tripathi, Director, AIIMS, Mangalagiri, Director of National Institute of Design, Vijayawada, Medical Superintendent and Dean of all the INI's and Many Faculties were present. As patient harm due to adverse events is 10th leading causes of death worldwide, most of these deaths and injuries are avoidable, 1 in 10 hospitalized patients experience harm, with 50% being preventable, around two-thirds of all adverse events resulting from unsafe care, therefore all the dignitaries stressed to implement strategies to reduce harm related to health care.

#### Faculty Development Program (07 -10.10.2021)

AIIMS Deoghar in collaboration with Advanced Center of Continuous Professional Development AIIMS Rishikesh conducted the 1st Faculty Development program from Oct 7 to 10 2021. The resource faculty from Rishikesh were Prof Shalinee Rao, Prof Pratima Gupta, Dr Farhanul Huda & Dr Gita Negi, Prof Saurabh Varshney ED and CEO was the resource person from AIIMS Deoghar. A total of 29 faculty from Deoghar were trained in recent teaching methods, medical education terms, techniques, assessment, curriculum planning etc.

#### **World Mental Health Day (10.10.2021)**

The Department of Psychiatry, AIIMS Deoghar celebrated this year's 'World Mental Health Day' 2021' (WMHD) in their beautiful campus here in Devipur. This very day is celebrated on 10<sup>th</sup> October each year and this very day carries with it a theme each year. The theme for this year WMHD is 'Mental Health in an Unequal World' and this is fixed every year by the 'World Federation for Mental Health' (WFMH). The theme signifies equitable distribution of quality mental health services across geographical, social, political, religious, ethnic and economic borders. To observe this day and to increase the awareness of mental health, the Department of Psychiatry, AIIMS Deoghar has organized a Hybrid Run event inside the AIIMS campus in which all the students of this institute, the faculties, nursing officers, housekeeping and other staffs participated wholeheartedly. The event kick-started with a brief welcome note by Dr. Santanu Nath, Assistant Professor, Department of Psychiatry where he welcomed the participants and introduced them the day. This was followed by an address by the Executive Director of AIIMS, Deoghar, Prof. (Dr) Saurabh Varshney.

#### World Osteoporosis Day (21.10.2021)

The Department of Orthopedic, AIIMS Deoghar had organized a free Bone Mineral Density (BMD) measurement camp on the occasion of World Osteoporosis day, 20.10.2021. More than 150 eligible Patients and Health care workers BMD measurement were done. Counselling and public awareness program regarding bone health was organized on this occasion.

#### **Good Clinical Practice Training Program (26.10.2021)**

The good clinical practice training program was conducted in hybrid mode on 26th October 2021. This program was organised by the Department of Pharmacology and Research Cell of AIIMS Deoghar. The expert speakers were from the eminent institutes of national importance like PGI-Chandigarh and ICMR. The faculties of AIIMS Deoghar have actually participated along with all the IEC members for learning and updating knowledge on the International and National GCP guidelines. The Honourable Director of AIIMS Deoghar had attended the program and presented the vote of thanks and issued the certificates to the successful participants.

#### 1st Pre-Conference CME (31.10.2021)

The Jharkhand State chapter of the Association of Clinical Chemistry and Lab Medicine Practitioners (ACCLMP) was formed by Prof (Dr) Vanita Lal (President) and Dr Anirban Ganguly (Organizing Secretary) on 14th July 2021. And soon after its formation, the department of Biochemistry AIIMS Deoghar in association of ACCLMP Jharkhand State Chapter and Ortho Clinical Diagnostics organised the First Pre Conference CME of ACCLMPCON (the national conference of ACCLMP) on 31st October,2021 at AIIMS Deoghar, Devipur Campus. This one day CME, conducted in the offline mode, had about 50 distinguished delegates coming from several states of India and was given full support by the Chief Patron and Executive Director (ED) of our institute Prof(Dr) Saurabh Varshney. The topic of the CME was "New Horizons in Biomarkers: Markers of Disease & Survival" which was adequately covered by four elaborate talks and a vibrant panel discussion.













#### World Antimicrobial Awareness week 2021

(Jointly organised by Department of Pharmacology, Microbiology and Community & Family Medicine) (18-24.11.2021)

The 'World Antimicrobial Awareness Week 2021 'was observed at AIIMS Deoghar between 18<sup>th</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> November 2021. During this Week various activities were organized in the institute including one day CME, patient awareness and survey and various competitions.

One day CME was organized in hybrid mode in which inaugural address was delivered by the Executive Director, Dr G jahnavi introduced the theme of the awareness week i.e. 'Spread awareness ,Stop Resistance', Dr.(Prof.) Pratima Gupta, Dr.(Prof.) S R Patra, Dr. Sarthak Das and Dr. Vikas Maharshi threw light on microbiological, surgical, clinician's and pharmacological perspective of antimicrobial resistance respectively.

In three day patient awareness and survey program, relevant video was displayed in AYUSH(OPD) building for patients and their attendants. WHO recommended questionnaire was also used to take survey of their current knowledge/awareness regarding antimicrobial uses and resistance. Various competitions organized like handmade/digi poster, Slogans, short essay, real life antimicrobial success /failure story related to the topic were invited. Faculty members and students showed their interest actively participated in the competitions.

The benefit of this telemedicine services of AIIMS Deoghar was not only utilised by people of Jharkhand, but also people of adjacent states like Bihar and West Bengal were also beneficial of these services. Around 1000 people have taken the benefit of speciality telemedicine services of AIIMS Deoghar so far.










**VISION:**-To be recognized as a leading institution, offering supremacy in quality of nursing education to promote patient care and research activities.


**MISSION:** To provide excellence in professional Nursing Education, with emphasis on human caring, holistic health and to promote research.

#### **Simulation based skill Labs**
