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INTRODUCTION

1. AIIMS, Deoghar

All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Deoghar, established in 2019 under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY) by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India, is an autonomous Institute of National Importance spread across a massive 237-acre campus in Devipur, Jharkhand. It was founded with the core mission of correcting regional imbalances in healthcare and achieving self-sufficiency in quality medical education in Eastern India. The institute offers premier academic programs including MBBS (with a 125-seat intake via NEET-UG), B.Sc. Nursing, M.Sc Nursing, Ph.D Programme, PDCC (Post-Doctoral Certificate Courses), PDF (Post Doctoral Fellowship), BPH+MPH, B.Sc Allied Health Course and Postgraduate (MD/MS) courses via INI-CET, all supported by fully digitized smart classrooms and advanced research laboratories. Furthermore, it houses a state-of-the-art 750+ bed multi-specialty and super-specialty hospital that delivers highly affordable, world-class tertiary patient care, trauma facilities, and extensive clinical exposure to its students, making it a leading center of medical excellence in the region. The Institute is a residential University in which the faculty members, staff and the students live on campus. There are hostels for undergraduate and postgraduate students inside the campus.

2. AIMS & OBJECTIVES

The aims and objectives of AIIMS Deoghar are to select the nation's most meritorious students through highly competitive national entrance exams like NEET-UG and INI-CET, ensuring a transparent, merit-driven enrollment process. The institute then focuses on transforming these top-tier candidates into exceptionally skilled, socially responsible, and ethically sound medical professionals. By offering subsidized, world-class academic training and extensive, hands-on clinical exposure within its 750+ bed super-specialty hospital, the admission process directly feeds into the objective of cultivating a highly competent medical workforce capable of elevating tertiary healthcare standards in Eastern India.

3. DURATION OF COURSE

The total duration of the M.B.B.S. (Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery) course at AIIMS Deoghar is 5.5 years (5 years and 6 months), which comprises 4.5 years of academic study, followed by 1-year mandatory rotating internship.

4. RESERVATION & NUMBER OF SEATS

The 125 (One Hundred and Twenty – Five) seats for Indian nationals are available for admission to MBBS course. The reservation matrix would be as per MCC directives.

5. ANTIRAGGING MEASURES

AIIMS Deoghar maintains a strict Zero-Tolerance Policy towards ragging in any form, aligning fully with the directives of the Honorable Supreme Court of India and National Medical Commission (NMC) regulations.

Ragging is treated as a severe, non-bailable criminal offense, and the campus ensures a safe, welcoming environment through dedicated institutional bodies like the Anti-Ragging Committee.

Any student found guilty of ragging, abetting it, or failing to report an incident can face severe institutional penalties including a heavy monetary fine, suspension from classes, cancellation of admission, eviction from the hostel, or immediate rustication—alongside formal criminal prosecution under the law. It is mandatory for every student and their parents to submit an electronic anti-ragging undertaking at the time of admission.

6. GENERAL

AIIMS Deoghar has a MBBS course divided into three professional divisions: First, Second and Third Professional MBBS are of one, one and half and two years duration respectively. The overarching goal is to cover the basics of all aspects of Medical Sciences. Admitted candidates must attend the Orientation Program and join classes on the stipulated date.

The admission of the candidates, who fail to join the course by the date stipulated in the letter of intimation, shall automatically be cancelled and such seats shall then be offered to the candidates on the waiting list in order of merit in the same category.

Candidates selected for admission to the MBBS course at the AIIMS Deoghar after verification of their eligibility and offered admission should bring the following original certificates/testimonials/documents at the time of admission:

7. AGE & QUALIFICATION

1. Should have attained or will attain the age of 17 (seventeen) years as on the 31st of December of the year of admission (2026) Candidates born on or before 31st December, 2009 are eligible.
2. Certificate of having passed the 10+2 or equivalent examinations, showing the subject offered by him/her in the examination
3. Certificate from the Board from which he/she passed the High School/Higher Secondary Examination, showing his/her date of birth.

4. Certificate/Mark Sheet from the Board from which he/she passed the 10+2 or equivalent examination showing that **for UR/OBC he/she has secured 60% or more marks (50% in case of SC/ST and 45% for Persons with Benchmark Disability) in aggregate in English, Physics, Chemistry and Biology.**
5. Migration Certificate from the university/Board last attended by him/her.
6. Applicable only to candidate belonging to Scheduled Caste/Tribe/OBC/OPH Category:
 - a. 2SC/ST Certificate issued by the competent authority. Community should be clearly mentioned in the certificate.
 - b. OBC Certificate issued by the competent authority. The sub-caste should tally with the central list of OBC. OBC candidates should not belong to creamy layer. OBC certificate must be in the prescribed format.
 - c. Certificate from prescribed authority showing that he/she belongs to persons with Benchmark Disability Category.

8. FEES & OTHER PAYMENTS:

The dues are to be paid immediately, after you have been declared medically fit in the Medical Board of the Institute as per details given below:

NOTE: - Rs. 30,000 (Imprest for Mess) must be deposited every 6 months throughout the MBBS course. Additional Charges payable if Mess bill exceeds Rs. 5,000 per month.

The details of mode of payment would be intimated to the selected candidates in due course.

9. ATTENDANCE

A minimum attendance for passing the MBBS course is mandatory.

Every MBBS student must obtain 75% attendance in aggregate in each of the subjects before they are permitted in the 1st, 2nd, and final professional examinations. This 25% relaxation includes all unavoidable reasons.

Any student with attendance less than the above norms will NOT BE PERMITTED IN THE 1st, 2nd, & final Professional Examination.

10. COMPULSORY ROTATORY INTERNSHIP TRAINING

After passing the final MBBS examination, all the candidates will be required to do compulsory internship for a period of one calendar year (12 months) in the hospital and rural health centers recognized by the AIIMS. During the internship period, the interns are allowed a total of 15 days leave in full term of one year. (Any modification of rules of internship will be notified separately).

The degree of MBBS shall be awarded after satisfactory completion of one year's internship.

NOTE: - AIIMS Deoghar reserves the right to suitably modify, update or delete or add any part of the prospectus as may be considered necessary by the competent authorities.

11. STUDENT INFORMATION SHEET

Hostel: It is mandatory for students to stay in the hostel during the tenure of the course after the admission process is over. Students are advised to bring/arrange following useful items of their own to ensure a comfortable stay:

- i. Utensils like water jug, tumbler/ jar, plastic bucket, Pillow, Bed Sheets.
- ii. The students have to buy their own textbooks, dissection sets/ any other ancillary items.

Dress Code:

(a) Wearing a white Doctor's Apron is mandatory during classes and academic activities.

(b) The specification of Doctor's Apron is as follows:

- i. Full sleeves
- ii. Length covering 2/3 of the thigh with two front lower pockets and one left side chest pocket.

(c) Dress code for students during college hours and academic activities is formal; Sneakers, Slippers, Jeans and T-shirts are not allowed during working hours.
