



STUDENT INFORMATION SHEET

Hostel: It is mandatory for students to stay in the hostel during the tenure of the course after the admission process is over. Students are advised to bring/arrange following useful items of their own to ensure a comfortable stay:

- i. Utensils like water jug, tumbler/jar, plastic bucket, Pillow, Bed Sheets.
- ii. The students have to buy their own textbooks, dissection sets/any other ancillary items.

Dress Code:

- (a) Wearing a white Doctor's Apron is mandatory during classes and academic activities.
- (b) The specification of Doctor's Apron is as follows:
 - i. Full sleeves
 - ii. Length covering 2/3 of the thigh with two front lower pockets and one left side chest pocket.
- (c) Dress code for students during college hours and academic activities is formal, Sneakers, Slippers, Jeans and T-shirts are not allowed during working hours.
